

Responsibilities and Organization Chart

University Librarian and Director of Academic Information Resources

The University Librarian and Director of Academic Information Resources is responsible to the Provost of the University for the administration of the Stanford University Libraries, campus-wide academic information and data resources, and academic computing within the University. The University Librarian and Director of Academic Information Resources is responsible for planning, specifying, and recommending structures and systems, as well as developing and implementing services within the University libraries that support research and instruction including academic computing functions. This includes the acquisition and availability of library collections and academic computing hardware and software, developing training and support programs for academic uses of computers, and establishing policies and standards to guide the utilization of academic information resources. This senior officer is also the publisher of HighWire Press, a supplier of Internet publishing services to scholarly publishers, and the publisher of the Stanford University Press, and in each case is responsible for strategic policies and directions. Each of these organizations has a managing director reporting to this officer.
