

## Responsibilities and Organization Chart General Counsel/Stanford Legal Office

The General Counsel is responsible to the Board of Trustees and the President of the University for the provision of legal services to the University and other units. He or she is responsible for the hiring, training and supervision of all University staff attorneys and for the retention, direction, and use of all outside counsel. Only the General Counsel may retain outside counsel to provide legal services to the University. The General Counsel ensures the appropriate use of legal services within the areas of responsibility of all University departments and serves as legal advisor to the University President, the Board of Trustees and all other units of the University.
